The First Tee of Orange County held its Fourth Annual Pro-Am at Coto de Caza Golf and Racquet Club on Monday, Aug. 29, and made a big splash for junior golf. The nonprofit organization dedicated to promoting healthy choices in young people through the game, raised \$125,000 on the day to help support scholarships, program improvements, equipment and more. Presented by Roger Dunn Golf Shops, the tournament featured competition on Coto de Caza's North and South courses. Andrew Larkin captured first place on the North course with a 6-under-par performance, while Dan Kupfer won top honors on the South course with a 7-under 65 in the professional competition.
